OSHA 10-HOUR COURSE OFFERED AT BX

## Take 10 hours for 10 safety hazards

Learn safety skills and hazard prevention during the next session of the OSHA 10-Hour Course offered at the Builders Exchange. The course will be held on Tuesday, March 10 and 12 from 8 to 2:30 p.m. each day. Registration and a continental breakfast begin at 7:30 a.m.

The program provides a brief review of the most dangerous and most frequently cited areas in construction. Even if you've taken the course before, new standards and practices are released regularly, so the BX recommends you attend the class every three years.

Topics include:

- fall protection
- electrical safety
- scaffolding
- trenching
- hand and power tools

Everyone who works in the construction industry should attend because every individual on your jobsite is exposed to the hazards the class discusses.

When you finish the class, you will receive a course completion card from the OSHA Training Institute.

The cost is \$129 per person for participants in the BX Workers' Comp Group, and \$209 for other BX members. The cost for nonmembers is \$369.

A volume discount of 10 percent is offered for companies sending five or more participants and 20 percent for 10 or more participants.

To receive refunds, cancellation requests must be made by Wednesday, March 3.
