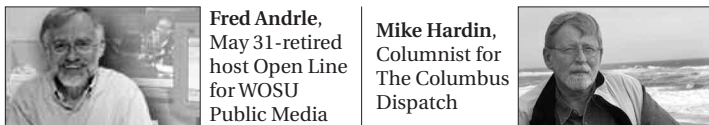

Mummies the Word

COSI & Columbus Museum of Art Bring Ancient Egypt to Columbus

May 30 COSI debuts the world premiere of the *Lost Egypt: Ancient Secrets, Modern Science* exhibition just as the Columbus Museum of Art wraps up *To Live Forever: Egyptian Treasures from the Brooklyn Museum* on June 7.

It's clear that modern civilization has a fascination with the mysteries of the mummy and ancient Egypt. Its primary cultural belief stretching thousands of years of Egyptian civilization was that you could live forever if you could overcome the enemy of death through luck and proper preparation.

CMA's *To Live Forever* features 109 works including some of the greatest masterworks of the Egyptian artistic tradition that illustrate Egyptian strategies for defeating death and living forever.

The COSI's *Lost Egypt* unearths the secrets of an ancient Egyptian world using the tools and technologies of archaeology and video guidance from archaeologists in the field to discover hidden stories, authentic artifacts and a human mummy. For the first-time ever, CT scans, forensic facial reconstructions and life-size rapid prototypes will take you beneath the mummy's wrappings. Equally cool and creepy!
