Greater Ohio: Prosperity for All

Lavea Brachman and **Gene Krebs** co-directors of Greater Ohio will discuss the findings of the organization's Restoring Prosperity Report. This three-year project analyzes why Ohio has experienced economic decline in a multitude of areas, while examining the ways in which the state has been efficient. A four-person panel of Ohio politicians, one from each caucus of the Ohio General Assembly will join Krebs in the discussion at CMC. Their comments will explore the

reasons the state and local government are on the verge of financial collapse. By illustrating where the weaknesses lie within the state, they hope to quell this potential economic disaster. They are calling on leaders from all walks to get involved in solving the state's financial woes and in saving our state. In addition to informing the public about the Greater Ohio campaign, the forum will also serve as a great opportunity for attendees' questions to be answered.


